This school year marks Mary Lee's 20th year of teaching at St. Martin's. She is the Coordinator for Innovation + Design in the Lower School, and also teaches Computer Science to students in Pre-K through 4th grades. The STeaM curriculum at St. Martin's introduces students the design thinking steps, which they will use for problem solving across all areas and subjects.

This semester, Mary Lee launched the first series of STeaM enrichment programs for the school's Beyond The Bell after school program, Robot Ruckus and Tech Time. Robot Ruckus introduces Pre-K, K and 1st graders to coding skills using a variety of robots in the STeaM Lab, including Beebots, Indi cars, and Dash robots to design programs to complete various tasks and challenges. In addition to coding skills, students will develop critical thinking and problem solving skills, as well as computational and critical thinking skills. Tech Time is a graphic design foundation class for students in 2nd through 4th grade. Students will learn design skills using Canva for Education to make their own creations and edit original videos.

What do you love most about your current role in Lower School?

I love the fact that I get to know each and every student in Lower School. I get the rare opportunity to teach each of them for six years and build meaningful relationships with the students over time.

The Homecoming Court


