## CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

## HAROLD HILL (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Harold Hill should be played by a boy with charisma and charm, who is comfortable on stage. He should be a great actor, singer, and mover. Cast someone who memorizes lines easily and has a good sense of musical rhythm. Your Harold should look good with your Marian and the two together should exude a spark of excitement.

Gender: Male
Vocal range top: G5
Vocal range bottom: B3

## MARIAN PAROO (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

The role of Marian is a different twist on the traditional leading lady. The character progresses greatly during the show, starting as an uptight librarian and transforming into a beautiful and trusting young woman. Marian must have an amazing voice, be an excellent actor, and be able to move well. She must also have an air of confidence.

Vocal range top: G5
Vocal range bottom: G3

## CHARLIE COWELL (ACTING ONLY ROLE)

The actor playing Charlie will perform in the ensemble or as a teen dancer or townsperson--just make sure it's clear he's NOT playing Charlie Cowell in those scenes. Cast a strong actor with a good loud voice. He should have a good sense of comic timing.
Gender: Male

## MAYOR SHINN (ACTING ONLY ROLE)

The actor playing Mayor Shinn certainly needs a good sense of comic timing, but should be able to perform the role very seriously. This is elemental in creating the humor of THE MUSIC MAN JR., which is based in reality. Mayor Shinn does not have to sing or dance, but he is responsible for a great deal of the pacing and line pick up in the show. Make sure your actor can memorize long monologues.

## EULALIE MACKECKNIE SHINN (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Everybody wants to play Eulalie. It's a great role for a great comic actress. If Eulalie takes herself seriously your audience will find her hysterical. Eulalie does have some singing and some dancing, or at least posing. Make sure your Eulalie works with your Mayor Shinn.

Vocal range bottom: D4
MARCELLUS WASHBURN (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)
This classic sidekick to Harold has been immortalized by comedic greats like Buddy Hacket. Marcellus' big number is "Shipoopi" so the character has to act well, sing reasonably well (although a character voice is best)
and be able to dance.

Vocal range bottom: E4
ETHEL TOFFELMIER (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)
Ethel is Marcellus's girlfriend. Ethel has some acting, some singing, and some dancing. Ethel is also one of the solo Pick-a-Little ladies.

Gender: Female
Vocal range top: D5
Vocal range bottom: D4

## MRS. PAROO (ACTING, SINGING ROLE)

Mrs. Paroo is the conscience of River City. She is a great mother, stands up for what she believes in, and gently pushes Marian to think of her future. The role requires an actress who can do a good Irish brogue, and who can sing and act.

She should also look right with Marian and Winthrop.

Vocal range bottom: -1

## WINTHROP PAROO (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Winthrop should appear to be young (his voice must be unchanged) and he should be a good actor. Winthrop also needs to be able to affect a believable lisp. Winthrop has to transform from a shy child to an outspoken child who not only sings but dances! **If cast from LS, this actor will be called to all rehearsals with MS and US cast***

## AMARYLLIS (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Amaryllis is the slightly bratty girl who studies piano with Marian. Amaryllis should be a good actor, and roughly the same size as Winthrop and Gracie. **|f cast from LS, this actor will be called to all rehearsals with MS and US cast*** Gender: Female

## EWART DUNLOP (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Ewart is part of the quartet, the member with the second highest voice or tenor. He is married to Maud Dunlop. Cast singers who can hold their own vocal parts strongly.

Vocal range top: F\#5
Vocal range bottom: E4

## OLIVER HIX (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Oliver is part of the quartet, the member with the second lowest voice or baritone. He is married to Alma Hix. Cast singers who can hold their own vocal parts strongly.
Gender: Male
Vocal range top: F\#5
Vocal range bottom: E4
JACEY SQUIRES (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)
Jacey is part of the quartet, the member with the highest voice or tenor. He is
married to Mrs. Squires. Cast singers who can hold their own vocal parts strongly.
Gender: Male
Vocal range top: A5
Vocal range bottom: B3

## OLIN BRITT (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Olin is part of the quartet, the member with the lowest voice or bass. Cast singers who can hold their own vocal parts strongly.

Gender: Male
Vocal range top: D5
Vocal range bottom: A3

## TOMMY DJILAS (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Tommy is the teen heartthrob in the show. Tommy's love interest is Zaneeta, so make sure the two characters have chemistry between them.

## ZANEETA SHINN (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Zaneeta should be your best female dancer. The role is often given dance
features in both "76 Trombones" and "Shipoopi." Zaneeta gets to deliver the classic "Ye gads" line! Gender: Female

## GRACIE SHINN (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

Gracie is Zaneeta's little sister. This role has one or two lines of dialogue. **If cast from LS, this actor will be called to all rehearsals with MS and US cast***

## ALMA HIX (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

One of the core members of the Pick-a-Little ladies, requiring girls with strong voices and a good sense of comedy. Alma is married to Oliver. You can also add additional Pick-a-Little ladies.

Vocal range top: D5
Vocal range bottom: D4

## MAUD DUNLOP (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)

One of the core members of the Pick-a-Little ladies, requiring girls with strong voices and a good sense of comedy. Maud is married to Ewart. You can also add additional Pick-a-Little ladies.

Gender: Female
Vocal range top: D5
Vocal range bottom: D4
MRS. SQUIRES (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLE)
One of the core members of the Pick-a-Little ladies, requiring girls with strong voices and a good sense of comedy. Mrs. Squires is married to Jacey. You can also add additional Pick-a-Little ladies.

Vocal range top: D5
Vocal range bottom: D4

## CONDUCTOR (ACTING, ONLY ROLE)

The conductor has the first line in the show, so cast an actor who is loud and energetic! Conductor will also be in the ensemble.

## CONSTABLE LOCKE (ACTING, ONLY ROLE)

The Constable is a quietly wise man who sees through Harold, but doesn't seem to mind.
Gender: Male

## ENSEMBLE (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLES)

The Ensemble is comprised of adult-types, teens and kids to play townspeople, traveling salesmen, teen dancers, Wa Tan Ye girls and the boys' band. Can accommodate additional Pick-a-Little ladies Gender: Any
TRAVELING SALESMEN (ACTING, SINGING, ROLES)
If you find it necessary to cast girls as traveling salesmen, make sure they play the roles as men.

TEEN DANCERS (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLES)
Make sure each Teen Dancer is assigned to a family to create the illusion of a real town.

WA TAN YE GIRLS (ACTING, SINGING, DANCING ROLES)
They are featured during Eulalie's "Spectacle" just prior to "76 Trombones." Gender: Female BAND
The Band has two main features: "76 Trombones" and the finale of the show. Gender: Any

1. I understand that my student may not be cast in Music Man Jr. $\qquad$
2. I understand that if my student is cast, he or she will be expected to attend all scheduled rehearsals and performances. $\qquad$
3. I understand that MANDATORY TECH Weeks are March 9-20, 2024. $\qquad$
4. I understand that my student's attendance is mandatory for the designated TECH Week. $\qquad$
5. I understand that no conflicts or late arrivals will be accepted for TECH Week. $\qquad$
6. I understand that all conflicts must be listed on this audition form. Additional conflicts will not be accepted once casting is complete. $\qquad$
7. I understand that if my student is ill, I must provide a valid doctor's note stating the student's condition and recovery time. This applies during regular rehearsals and TECH Week. $\qquad$
8. I am aware that should my student exceed the allotted number of absences, his/her role may be reassigned to another actor or my student may be dismissed from the cast.
9. I am aware that my student MUST be available for all performances. $\qquad$ 10. I am aware that my student needs a completed audition form, headshot, and resume to audition today. $\qquad$
10. I understand that the following supplies are required at every rehearsal: SCRIPT, pencil (sharpened), closed-toe shoes, appropriate clothing (please label all personal garments/shoes). $\qquad$
11. I understand that my student is not allowed to leave the theater to wander/run in the halls. He/she must let the Stage Manager /the Directors know when leaving or using the restroom.
12. Student may bring snacks, but they must clean up after themselves. No food or drinks are allowed in the theatre. Water bottles only in the theatre or backstage. $\qquad$
